

BASIC PRAIRIE SEED MIX

A general prairie grass and wildflower mix providing a solid variety of species at an affordable price, this mix features a broad palette of colorful species that should bloom soon after establishment. Adding seed or plant plugs at a later date is a wonderful way to increase a prairie's richness and diversity. This seed mix includes at least 6 of 7 native permanent grass and sedge species and 16 of 21 native forb species.

Andropogon gerardii Big Bluestem

Dry-to-Mesic Prairie / Savanna Grass



The primary grass species of the tallgrass prairie, this impressive 4'-8' tall plant blooms mid-summer to early fall. It is also called "turkey foot" for its 3-spiked inflorescence that resembles a bird's claw. Preferring full sun and dry-to-medium soil moisture, this species turns a bronze-gold color in late fall.

Asclepias tuberosa Butterfly Weed

Dry Prairie / Savanna Forb



A wonderful plant to attract butterflies, native bees, and wasps, this stunning orange-blooming wildflower prefers dry soils and full-to-partial sun. A favorite food plant of the caterpillar stage of the Monarch butterfly, this species grows to about 2' in height.
