

MESIC-TO-DRY TALLGRASS PRAIRIE SEED MIX

This is a broad-spectrum prairie grass and wildflower mix for sites with full sun and medium-to-dry soils. The height profile is more varied than the previous mix, with species ranging from short to tall. This profile creates a more diverse habitat, offering a variety of cover and food options for wildlife. This seed mix includes at least 6 of 7 native permanent grass and sedge species and 25 of 32 native forb species.

Panicum virgatum Switch Grass

Dry-to-Mesic Prairie Grass



This grass species is equally at home in moderately dry soils as it is in moderately wet soils. It prefers full sun and blooms from mid-summer to mid-fall. Reaching heights of 5', it forms a dense cover once established, which makes it perfect for wildlife habitat. In late fall, it turns a brownish-gold.

Monarda fistulosa Wild Bergamot

Dry-to-Mesic Prairie / Savanna Forb



This member of the mint family is striking in full bloom. A prairie and savanna species that prefers dry-to-mesic soils, it can be found in full and partial sun. Blooming from early to late summer, the dense flower heads are ringed with small, tubular lavender flowers. Growing up to 5' tall, this plant is a favorite with bumblebees and hawk moths.
